

HPTi Takes Home Three Stevie Awards In The 9TH Annual American Business Awards!

Reston, VA – June 22, 2011 – High Performance Technologies, Inc., (HPTi) took home Financial Executive of the Year, Product Developer of the Year, and Technical Professional of the Year for the prestigious American Business Awards, also known as the “Stevies.”

Referred to as “the business world’s own Oscars” by the New York Post (New York Post, April 27, 2005), the American Business Awards are the only national awards program that honor and recognize the multiple facets of the business world.

Despite competition from around the country, HPTi set a company record, taking home three awards in 2011. Bill Milligan, HPTi’s Chief Financial Officer, was named Finance Executive of the Year, Steve Klotz, a Senior Developer at HPTi, won Product Developer of the Year, and Tom Simmavath, HPTi’s 2010 employee of the year, won Technical Professional of the Year.

With Bill in the financial driver’s seat, HPTi won nearly \$200 million in new contracts in 2010, while growing a backlog of over \$480 million. Steve Klotz played a key role in the managing the master script and software support of the Navy Ensemble Post-Processing System which gives the Navy the ability to produce more accurate climate change predictions and weather forecasts. Tom Simmavath’s expansive knowledge has provided tool development, systems assurance, and quality assurance in the tools needed to field effective fire control systems for many of America’s artillery systems.

HPTi continued its tradition of excellence with the American Business Awards. Of the 11 submissions sent to the program, 11 were chosen as finalists: Steve Klotz, Product Developer of the Year, Laura Chamberlain, Communications Professional of the Year, Robert Jones, Customer Service Executive of the Year, Veterans Affairs Support Team, Support Team of the Year, Eleni Antoniou, Human Resources Executive of the Year, Bill Milligan, Finance Executive of the Year, HPTi Internal Trade Show, Best Internal Recognition/Motivational Event, Tom Simmavath, Technical Professional of the Year, HPTi Cloud Computing Team, Information Technology Team of the Year, Diane Lambkin, Information Technology Executive of the Year, and HPTi Cares, Corporate Social Responsibility Program of the Year.

The awards ceremony was held at the Marriot Marquis Hotel in New York City on Monday, June 20. Hosted by Cheryl Casone of FOX Business Network, the ceremonies were videocast live on the Internet and broadcast nationwide on radio.

This year attracted over 2,800 entries from organizations of all types and sizes across the U.S.A., setting an all-time record. These entries were reviewed by 80 professionals in preliminary judging, and their average scores determined the Finalists. Stevie Award winners were selected from among the Finalists by the average scores of the members of 10 specialized final judging committees. Over 200 professionals participated in the 2011 judging process.
